

Information on AS Marks – Outgoing Specifications

This information is relevant to L6 students sitting outgoing AS specifications only (this does not apply to Cambridge International Examination AS Levels):

Lower Sixth students sitting outgoing modular AS specifications will not normally at this stage receive an overall AS Grade. Whether to cash-in at this stage will be discussed with the students on their return in September. However, it is possible for you to work out what the AS grade *would* be by the following procedure.

The maximum total mark for the sum of the AS units added together in a particular subject is: 300 for three AS subjects; and 200 for the two unit AS subjects. Check the specification or discuss this with your teacher.

3 Unit

240+ would be a grade A
210+ would be a grade B
180+ would be a grade C
150+ would be a grade D
120+ would be a grade E
<120 would be a grade U (Unclassified)

2 Unit

160+ would be a grade A
140+ would be a grade B
120+ would be a grade C
100+ would be a grade D
80+ would be a grade E
<80 would be a grade U (Unclassified)

The two AS units for **Chinese** together have a maximum of 100. Therefore:

80+ would be a grade A
70+ would be a grade B
60+ would be a grade C
50+ would be a grade D
40+ would be a grade E
